

COLLAB TOWER

Building a tower in a team can help a group discuss topics, learn to work together and practice communication. There can be many versions of this team building strategy. Teams can write words on the sticky notes and bid with them, facilitators can eliminate forms of communication in the game and the materials used can be different. By creating something together, the teams will hopefully build culture and be able to work together better.

DIRECTIONS:

- You will be given SEVEN MINUTES to plan and build your tower.
- You will have FIVE MINUTES for the actual construction of the tower.
- While you plan, you can talk to each other, write things down and work together.
- While you build the tower, you may NOT SPEAK to each other.
- Instead of planning, the first 2 minutes can be used to brainstorm words about a certain topic like collaboration. Students can then discuss the words and use the to build the tower.
- You can limit the number of notes they use based on what you want them to complete.

Materials: Post-It Notes

Time Required: 15 minutes

Group Size: 4 - 8 people.
