FAST VERB

Fast Verb is a great way to get feedback on an initial attempt at something – or if you're stuck and you need some fresh perspective.

This protocol is best done with 5–8 people in a group – but could be done with a few more or a few less. It can also be done with lots of different ideas/topics.

DIRECTIONS:

Have participants sit in a circle or around a table in groups of 4–5. If they're working on school related material, have them sit in either similar content areas or similar grade levels.

One way to use this protocol would be for participants to create a driving question for a project they might want to work on in the near future. Once they have written the question on a sheet of paper using the rubric format, participants will pass their paper to the person next to them for them to rewrite or tweak the question. Give one minute for each pass.

Continue this process until the person who wrote the question has their own question back. Now you will have 5 driving questions to work with!

You can use the process for all types of questions or statements.
