STORY BOARDING

CONCEPT:

An idea or concept is subdivided into meaningful individual images and visualized sketchily. Each picture should have directional character. The individual images are then arranged in a logical sequence. The pictures will tell a story to help people visualize your solution or ideas. Try to use as few words as possible.

TOOLS:

Paper, pen

GOALS:

Imparting an idea or a concept through a sequence of simplified visualizations.

DIRECTIONS:

It is helpful to give the students a template or have them create one (e.g. 6-8 boxes or scenes). In each box have the students draw a part of their idea/concept. They can build on the idea in each box. Visualize the process step by step. Quality of the descriptions depends on the style and skill of the storyboarder. It is great to have the students share out and walk through their ideas.
