VOICE & CHOICE

Giving students voice and choice (the ability to choose what they will do and how they will do it - essentially putting their own stamp on things) is essential to making any project-based learning unit feel authentic and meaningful to them.

Often giving students voice and choice is limited to offering them options in terms of how they will present or represent the solution they develop to the driving question.

This is good, but (if possible) students could be given greater opportunities to express who they are and how they would like to do things.
